# **Community Response Meeting on Graphic Anti-**Abortion Flyers - 7 PM Thursday, August 31

Recently, there have been very graphic anti-abortion flyers being distributed by the Canadian Centre for Bio-Ethical Reform (CCBER). Many residents have been deeply concerned by these flyers.

Last week Toronto-Danforth MPP Peter Tabuns, Councillor Paula Fletcher (Ward 30), Councillor Mary Fragedakis (Ward 29) and TDSB Trustee Jennifer Story sent a letter to the Attorney General asking the Wynne government for an injunction to block the use of disturbing images being distributed in our area by this anti-abortion group..
