RTCC walked - and hosted - Nellie's "Coldest Night!"

On Saturday, February 22nd, members of the RTCC Board (*Christine, Janet and Alan, pictured below*) participated in the Coldest Night of the Year Charity Walk, along with thousands of other Canadians across the country. The walk in Riverdale, which kicked off at the RTCC, directly benefited Nellie's, an emergency women's shelter for women and children. In addition to fundraising, volunteers experienced first hand what it is like to be out in the cold during the winter in order to bring awareness to the challenges of being homeless. Over \$52,000 was raised in total for Nellie's WEAV program.

Due to the generosity of our donors, including members of the RTCC board and family/friends/supporters, we raised a total of \$2,000, placing 6th place out of 21 teams!!! These proceeds/donations will go directly to the most vulnerable population in our community.

Summer Camp Counsellor

The Ralph Thornton Community Centre (RTCC) is a dynamic neighbourhood centre involved in community development and social justice in South Riverdale. We collaborate with others to create a healthy, inclusive and vibrant community

We are seeking Camp Counsellors for our summer Riverdale Adventure Centre (RAC) Camp. This position is responsible for providing a safe, fun, and enriched camp experience for children ages 6-12 within the stated RAC policies and procedures. Under the directions of the Coordinator of RAC, Coordinator of the Summer Mentor Program, and the Manager of Strategic Initiatives, and in collaboration with other counsellors and specialists, the counsellor is responsible for planning and implementing daily recreation programs. The RAC camp is offered to local residents with dedicated spaces for children from low income and LGBTQ+ families

- Plan and implement age appropriate recreation programs;
- Supervise children in program;
- Prepare regular program plan;
 Collect all camper attendance and permission records required for camp activities;
- Update inventory reports relating to first aid and program supplies;
- Communicate to parents regarding camp activities
- Report regularly to the camp Coordinators and/or Manager of Strategic Initiatives and participates
- Assist in the evaluation of the RAC program
- Follow camp policies and procedures; and, Perform other camp related duties as assigned by the camp Coordinators and/or Manager of

- 1 year previous experience working with children
- Recreational programming skills--program planning and implementation Effective communication skills--written and verbal
- Emergency First Aid and CPR-C (training will be made available prior to the start of camp)
 Must be between the ages of 16 and 30 years at the start of employment
- Residence in Rivertowne, LGBTQ+ background, and/or Chinese language skills an asset.

Rate of Pay: \$15.00 (As Summer Program Staff, this position is excluded from CUPE Local 2998) June 29, 2020 through August 28, 2020, inclusive. Mandatory training offered prior to the start of camp on July 6, 2020.
