We will show respect at all times for all people who visit the Centre. We make every effort to apply conduct guidelines in a fair and positive manner for the benefit of all.

We ask all visitors to treat the Centre, its resources, and other visitors with respect, for the benefit and enjoyment of everyone in the community.

Visitors to the Centre CANNOT:

- Use threatening, abusive, or harassing language or behavior towards staff, volunteers, participants, or other visitors to the Centre.
- Behave in a way that may be perceived as disruptive or intrusive by others.
- Willfully mistreat, damage, destroy, or steal property belonging to the Centre or visitors to the Centre.
- Leave children under 12 unsupervised on the premises.
- Give out the Ralph Thornton Community Centre phone and/or fax number as a contact.
- Use roller blades or skateboards inside the building.
- Bring bicycles inside the building.
- Bring animals inside the building, except for service animals or those in authorized programs.
- Leave items unattended. The Centre is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
